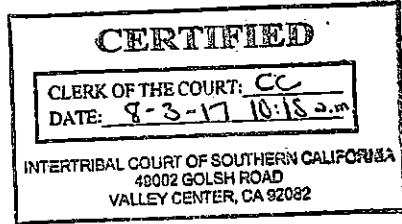

ORDER AFTER HEARING

This matter came before the Intertribal Court of Southern California on July 31, 2017 at 10:00 a.m. The Honorable Gregory Thompson, associate judge, presided.

Michael Ydigoras, plaintiff, did not appear. The Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians, defendant, appeared through counsel, Ryan Blackstone-Gardner of Greene & Roberts LLP.

The Court, having made the relevant inquiries of these parties, finds as follows:

1. Good notice was provided to all parties.
2. Jurisdiction is proper pursuant to the laws, customs, and traditions of the Rincon Band of Luiseño Indians.

The Court indicated that it received a Request for Dismissal without prejudice from Michael Ydigoras on July 28, 2107.


1 The Court further indicated that, on the morning of the hearing, Michael Ydigoras reiterated to the
2 Court his intent that the matter be dismissed and expressed his consent to the hearing proceeding in
3 his absence. Ryan Blackstone-Gardner stated that the Band has no opposition to the dismissal.

4 The Court, having heard this testimony and having reviewed the record and applicable law,
5 orders as follows:

- 6 1. This matter shall be dismissed without prejudice.
- 7 2. The Court's jurisdiction in this matter shall be terminated.
