**ORDER OF DISMISSAL WITH  
PREJUDICE**

On November 26, 2018, the Court set a telephonic Status Conference to be held on December 12, 2018 at 10:00 a.m. Notice of the Status Conference was served on Petitioner, Dino S. Cantoria, and on Respondent's counsel.

On December 12, 2018, at 10:00 a.m., the Court held the telephonic Status Conference. Respondent participated in the Status Conference through its counsel. However, Petitioner Dino S. Cantoria did not appear or participate in the Status Conference and did not notify Respondent's counsel or the Court that he would not be appearing. After waiting approximately 10 minutes for Petitioner to appear, the Court suspended the Status Conference.

Due to the failure to appear for the December 12, 2018 Status Conference, the Court issued an Order to Show Cause to Petitioner Dino Cantoria and set it for telephonic hearing on January 10, 2019, at 11:00 a.m. Pursuant to the Order to Show Cause, Petitioner Dino Cantoria was ordered to appear and show cause at the January 10, 2019 hearing as to why this case should not be dismissed for his failure to appear for the December 12, 2018 telephonic Status Conference and for his failure


1 to prosecute this action. Notice of the Order to Show Cause that included the telephone number and  
2 access code for the hearing, was served on Respondent's counsel and on Petitioner, Dino S.  
3 Cantoria, by Certified Mail. Petitioner, Dino S. Cantoria, signed the Return Receipt on December  
4 17, 2018, confirming that he had been served with the notice of the Order to Show Cause notice.  
5 The copy of the Return Receipt bearing Petitioner Dino S. Cantoria's signature was delivered to the  
6 Court on December 20, 2018.

7 On January 10, 2019, at 11:00 a.m., the Court held the telephonic Order to Show Cause  
8 hearing. Respondent participated in the Status Conference through its counsel. Petitioner Dino S.  
9 Cantoria, however, did not appear or participate in the Order to Show hearing, did not notify  
10 Respondent's counsel or the Court that he would not be appearing, and did not request a  
11 continuance of the same. After waiting approximately 15 minutes for Petitioner to appear, the  
12 Court concluded the Order to Show Cause hearing.

13 As a result of Petitioner Dino Cantoria's failure to appear at the January 10, 2019 Order to  
14 Show Cause hearing and show cause to the satisfaction of the Court on as to why he failed to appear  
15 for the December 12, 2018 Status Conference and for his failure to prosecute this action, the Court  
16 hereby dismisses the above-named action with prejudice.
